WAIVER FOR PARADE PARTICIPANTS

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I UNDERSTAND AND AGREE that there is potential risk for injury involved in the training and participation of any physical activity. I further understand and agree that participating in the Pete Knight Days Parade is a potentially dangerous activity. Bumps, bruises, scrapes, scratches and soreness are commonplace, and most participants will encounter this sort of minor injury from time to time. More serious injuries are possible, including sprains, strains, twists, cramps, and injuries of similar magnitude. The possibility of more serious injury exists, including fractured bones, broken bones, torn ligaments, though most participants do not encounter such serious injuries. There remains, despite safety precautions, the remote possibility of crippling or death. **I FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ACKNOWLEDGE** all such risks, dangers and hazards, resulting from my participation in any event hosted or sponsored by the Crossfield Rodeo Society.

I am also aware that I should discuss my participation in this activity with my physician to determine the effect on my current health.

It is my right and responsibility as a participant to immediately remove myself from participation in the program and notify the nearest official, if at any time I sense any unusual hazard or unsafe condition or if I feel that I am physically, emotionally, or mentally unfit for continued participation in the program.

I have read and understand the above statement of risk. I assume responsibility for my own safety, and I understand and accept the risks involved with my participation.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

I hereby agree as follows:

TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIM that I have or may in future have against the Crossfield Rodeo Society., its coaches, officials, members, agents, directors, officers, employees and representatives, and other participants (all of whom are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Releasees".

We're looking forward to a fantastic Saturday morning, with hopefully more than 50 entries expected. The parade will go ahead rain or shine, so please dress for the weather and bring your parade spirit!

Placement Lineup

- A few days before the parade you will receive a lineup order list in your email.

Arrival & Staging

- Arrival Time: 9:30–10:00 a.m.
- Check-In Location: Corner of Mountain Ave and Railway Street. Look for signage
- Friendly volunteers will be on site to check you in and guide you to your staging spot.
- Horse riders will stage on the grass area north of the Fire Hall.

Road Closure:

The parade route will be closed starting at 9:30 a.m. between the Fire Hall and the back of the WG Murdoch School at McCaskill.

Please access staging from the west side on Whitfield Avenue only.

No access from Mountain Avenue (Arena) or Railway (Fire Hall).

- Horse trailers may park behind WG Murdoch School as in previous years.
- Gates open at 9:00 a.m.
(And yes, please clean up any apples your horses may drop ☐.)

Check-In & Waivers

- All participants must have a signed waiver on file (parent/guardian signature required for minors).
- Waivers may be emailed in advance or handed in at check-in.
Waivers are required for insurance purposes, entries without one won't be able to participate.
- Parade Officials reserve the right to refuse entries that do not match their application description (unless they arrive looking even better!).
- There is zero tolerance for entries promoting hate, discrimination, or intolerance.

Judging

Judging will take place from 10:00 to 10:45 AM.

Please arrive and check in before 10:00 AM to be eligible.

Judging is based on:

- Overall appearance
- Parade theme
- Crowd appeal
- Originality and creativity

Safety First

- Safety is top of mind for everyone, especially children, animals, and volunteers.
- Reminder, not to hand out all your candy on Railway Street,
- Please **do not** throw candy or give-aways; walkers should hand items directly to spectators
- Be mindful of noise around horses, we love having horses in the parade and we want to keep them calm before the parade starts.
- Arrive on time and line up in your assigned order so we can start promptly

Parade Route & After the Parade

- Please keep pace with the parade route as best you can, keeping in mind the many walkers there will be. Fun interactions are encouraged!
Water guns and spraying are welcome toward spectators only, not other parade entries.
- After the parade, roads will reopen to traffic. Please use caution as you exit the route on Whitfield Avenue behind the schools.
